CONFINED SPACE

RIIWH5202E – Enter and work in confined spaces

Confined Space training is appropriate for those persons working in a confined space for the purpose of carrying out work or inspections and for those performing stand-by person roles.

Course Objectives

Confined Space Initial training equips participants with the knowledge and skills to safely enter and work in confined spaces, avoiding exposure to hazardous substances, flammable or explosive conditions or other safety or health issues.

Confined Space Refresher training is designed to refresh previously trained persons in the legislative requirements to ensure their skills are maintained. Australian Standard 2865-2009 notes - Persons shall be reassessed at appropriate intervals to maintain their competency to conduct tasks associated with confined spaces.

On successful completion, each participant will be issued with a Statement of Attainment.
