WORKING AT HEIGHTS

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to work safely at heights in the resources and infrastructure industries. It applies to those working in operational roles. They generally work under supervision to undertake a prescribed range of functions involving known routines and procedures and take responsibility for the quality of work outcomes.

Course Outline

- WHS legislation and regulations related to working at heights
- Safe use of anchor points, harnesses, fall arrest devices, and associated equipment, including understanding the forces generated during a fall
- Identification and control of hazards when working at heights
- Selection and correct use of different types of height safety equipment, including harnesses, fall arrest devices, and other safety devices
- Restrictions and limitations on certain equipment
- Practical training in accessing and working safely at heights
